On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Tamil Nadu has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for increasing the annual intake of MBBS course from 150 to 250 seats subject to the condition that the approval of Government of India and National Medical Commission should be obtained before the students are admitted to the additional 100 MBBS seats subject to the following conditions and also to fulfill the other associated conditions for approval by National Medical Commission is solely vested with the applicant;

- a) additional Bank Guarantee for two crore as per the norms of the National Medical Commission should be submitted.
- b) the availability of 100% faculties, infrastructures, equipment (clinical and non-clinical) as per the National Medical Commission norms for 250 seats, to be ensured before the National Medical Commission inspection without-fail.
- c) to fulfill and comply with shortage of infrastructural facilities as per the National Medical Commission norms for 250 seats.
- d) the Trust should abide National Medical Commission's norms updated from time to time without any lapse.
- e) to ensure all the mandatory certificates should be updated and its validity should also be verified before the National Medical Commission inspection, viz;
 - Building completion certificate by Public Works Department.
 - Building stability certificate by Public Works Department.
 - Certificate for Fit to run an educational institution by the appropriate authority
 - Blood bank and Blood component separation license certificate
 - PCPNDT Certificate.
 - Approval from AERB, Mumbai (For building and equipments)
 - Pollution control board certificate
 - Fire safety certificate
 - Environmental Impact Assessment Certificate

It is certified that:-

- a) It is desirable to increase the annual intake in MBBS course from 150 to 250 seats in the public interest.
- b) Increasing the annual intake in MBBS course from 150 to 250 seats by Trichy SRM Medical College Hospital & Research Centre is feasible.
- c) The institution has 1070 number of teaching beds with the standing of 10 years.
- d) The average OPD strength per day is 2036.
- e) The average bed occupancy is 75%
